Pre-Program Monitoring

1. Regardless of physical symptoms, all staff and campers must be tested for COVID-19 antibodies on or after 9/1/2020. Results must be faxed to 516-612-3924 or emailed to ayalah@projectextreme.org.
2. If campers or staff test negative for antibodies, a COVID-19 test must be administered 3 days before the program. Results must be faxed to 516-612-3924 or emailed to ayalah@projectextreme.org.
3. 14 days before the commencement of the Project Extreme program, all campers and staff must be monitored for symptoms of COVID-19. A completed COVID screening form must be emailed or faxed to the Project Extreme office.

As indicated by the CDC, COVID-19 Symptoms, are:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath/difficulty of breathing

Or two of the following symptom:

- Fever
- Chills
- Tremors
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

4. Upon arrival at the program all participants and staff will be screened for symptoms.

Program Monitoring

1. While camp is in session, campers and staff will be screened for symptoms via questionnaire and temperature check every 72 hours.
2. Results for each camper's routine monitoring will be logged by camp staff.

Communication

A communications plan will be developed for staff, parents/guardians, and campers that includes applicable instructions, training, signage, and a consistent means to provide information.

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Emergency Contacts listed on program application must reside within the USA and be available for contact 24 hours/day.

Staff Training

All camp staff will be trained on applicable COVID-19 precautions and policies.

Sanitization

1. Sanitizer will be available for camper and staff at designated locations throughout the grounds. Signage will be posted throughout the camp regarding requirements of hand sanitation
2. Campers and staff shall follow CDC hand washing guidelines: before and after preparing or serving food, treating a cut or wound, a using the bathroom, or after touching an animal, animal food or waste, or garbage.
3. Cleaning and disinfecting supplies will be provided for all shared and frequently touched surfaces.

Visiting Guidelines

1. All non-essential visitors will be prohibited.
2. There are no approved visiting hours and no visitors to the program will be admitted.

Treatment

1. Any camper or staff member showing symptoms associated with COVID-19 will be immediately isolated in the designated area and will be subject to PCR test for COVID-19 administered by a physician.
2. Arrangements will be made for the immediate transfer of an infected camper or staff to the care of the parents/guardian, to be returned home or to emergency services in the unlikely event of an acute medical emergency.
3. Parents or guardians will be required to pick up infected campers directly from the program location. Air travel or mass transit cannot be used by an individual exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19.

COVID-19 Refund Policy

1. In the event that a camper is unable to attend the program due to COVID-19, tuition monies will be refunded.
2. If a camper arrives at camp and needs to be sent home because they have been infected with COVID-19, no refund will be extended.

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Air Travel Policy

All air-travel questions must be directed to your specific airline. It is advised to know the airlines refund policy prior to booking. Project Extreme is not responsible for the costs of canceled or missed flights.

Waiver

Despite careful attention to safety protocol, there is still a chance that staff and participants could be exposed to COVID-19. I accept the risk and consent to attend.

All staff and campers, and parents/guardians of campers, must affirm that they have reviewed and understand the COVID-19 guidelines.
